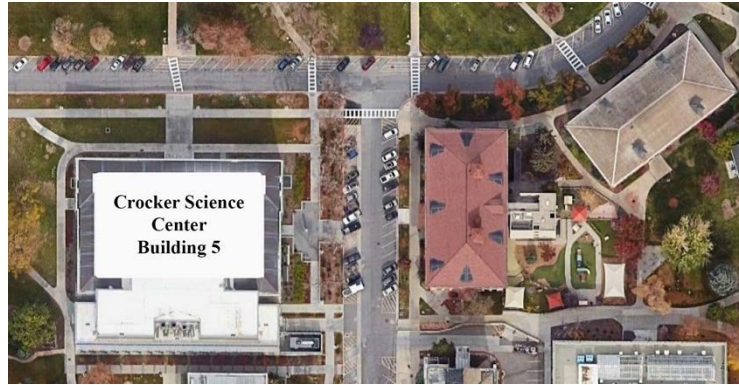


Directions to Cell Imaging at The Crocker Science Center, Building 5

The Cell Imaging Core maintains microscopes and an office in The Crocker Science Center (CSC), Building 5.

CSC is on the South side of Presidents Circle. If you are not familiar with the location, please use the campus map (<https://bit.ly/2okx1I9>).



The Cell Imaging microscopes and office are in the lower level of the building. Card access is required for the basement hallway as well as Room 32. Please note that North side of CSC has a Level 0 (with classrooms) between the first floor and the lower level. The freight elevator is the only ADA access to the classroom floor. Either elevator, or the stairway will take you to the lower level.

The East side entrance brings you to the lobby of the building. The first hall to the left provides access to the elevators and, further on, a stairway down to the lower level. Once in the lower level, there is a white double door with a card reader. This is the central hallway. Rooms 30 and 32 are at the West end of the hallway. Room 32 houses microscopes for many labs. The microscopes maintained by the Cell Imaging Core are all along the far, or South, wall.
